Phone: 765-285-5600. **Preference is given to non-traditional male and female students. We define non-traditional as someone who has independent status and has returned to school following extended absence of at least 5 years.** Scholarships in the amount of at least \$1,500 will be awarded for the 2019-20 academic year.

Applicants must fulfill the following scholarship requirements:

1. Completion of 24 semester hours, of which 15 were at Ball State University;
2. Have at least a 3.0 grade point average;
3. Be enrolled half time or more (at least six credit hours per semester);
4. Be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree at Ball State University;
5. Completion of the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** form available at the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid or www.FAFSA.ed.gov due **April 15 for Indiana assistance.**

Criteria for the Awards

Non-traditional students are age 24 or more. Scholastic ability, industry, integrity, financial need and the promise of being enabled by continuing education to become a leading citizen in the community, state and nation, as well as meeting the five requirements above, are consideration for these scholarships.
